TREASURER'S REPORT 1 JANUARY 2020 TO 31 DECEMBER 2020

Covid 19 may well have changed our lives in 2020; it did not change the fact that the group's two main sources of income are our members who continue to support the group by paying a fee of £5 per annum and the moneys the group receives from IAM when new associates join the group.

In the past calendar year income from the renewal of membership fees increased slightly from the 2019 figure of £240 to £260. Many members continue to choose to renew for 2 years. We lose some members each year, as there will always be those who wish to take the Advanced Driving Test and then leave the Moray Group. Sadly a number fail to renew their IAM membership which then renders them ineligible to be a group member. Access to the national database allows me to check that a person is still eligible to be a group member before I send an invitation to stay with the Moray group. I just wish that, if a national member decides not to support the local group, that person would have the courtesy to advise us. All too often that does not happen.

In 2020 we received a total of £20 in donations and after a committee decision to sell our Easy Up gazebo we received a very generous offer of £100 for this.

Where Covid 19 has hit the group hard is in the income we have received from RoadSmart enrolments. In 2020 enrolments generated a mere £196, down from £481 in 2019. Once again this took into account the annual insurance which is deducted from the money owed to us by London.

Expenditure in 2020 was also affected greatly by Covid. No gatherings meant that there was no need to hire accommodation so our expenditure for this reduced to £60.45 from £174.33. We spent a total of £114.98 on publicity, viz. our website, £54.99 on books and one young driver received £30 cashback, as promised, for passing the Advanced Test.

At the end of the financial year we had a bank balance of £2344.15 plus £13.76 in cash. Our financial position is stronger than it was 12 months ago, sadly for the wrong reasons, and there continues to be no need to propose any change to the Moray Group membership fee.
