TREASURER'S REPORT 1 JANUARY 2023 TO 31 DECEMBER 2023

Group income in 2023 improved from the 2022 situation, as more normality returned to life and it was possible to accept more new associates. As a result the group received a total of £365 from IAMRoadsmart, £36.50 for each new associate being prepared by the Moray Group. Group membership fees are always slightly lower in an odd-numbered year because of the fact that we first offered 2 year membership in an even-numbered year. Taking together members who pay for one year and two years our income for this was £145. The only other income was a £10 donation.

Expenditure was somewhat higher in 2023. £173.75 was spent on accommodation for meetings. Group insurance is something all groups are required to pay to IAM each year and in 2023 this was set at £176,79. Groups are not consulted about this; they are told how much they are paying and I will advise you now that the cost for 2024 is more than £200. The group spent £487,80 on publicity, both print and internet. While it could be argued that it does not seem to bring us much, it does ensure that we have a visible presence and the group website does bring us new associates. In 2023 the committee agreed to provide mentors with reference books to assist them and we spent a total of £265,37 on these. Expenses for attendance at the Scottish conference came to £122. Once upon a time subsidies were provided to assist all groups to attend these but this is no longer the case.

With a total income of £520 and a total expenditure of £1225,71 the group has recorded a loss of £705,71 in 2023. However, despite this our funds remain healthy with a bank balance on 31 December of £1879.74 plus £8.76 held in cash.
