The group held its first successful social gathering this year with some good feedback and the intentions of the group doing more in 2023.

Members of the committee attended the IAM Annual Symposium at Crieff in October 2022 where workshops were created to allow for the IAM to gauge our thoughts. The meeting was very successful. A major change to the IAM is the way observing is to be conducted. In short, the LO qualification will cease to exist by April 2025.

With the cost-of-living affecting everything, the cost of completing the IAM training remains one of the most competitive prices in Scotland.

A thanks to members of the group who volunteered to support the Police Scotland Motorcycling riding campaign. This saw members working along side the police in delivering a short introduction into advanced riding. Already, people have been approached to do the same again in 2023.

A reminder to the group is, as per the group rules, the Chairman cannot stand for more than three years as Chair and therefore must stand down at the end of year three. The position can only be filled by someone who has been on the committee in the previous year. If the group is to carry on it must have the full support!
